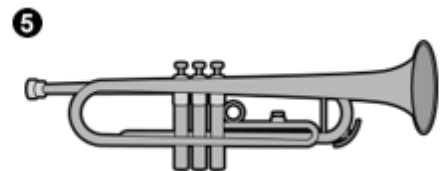
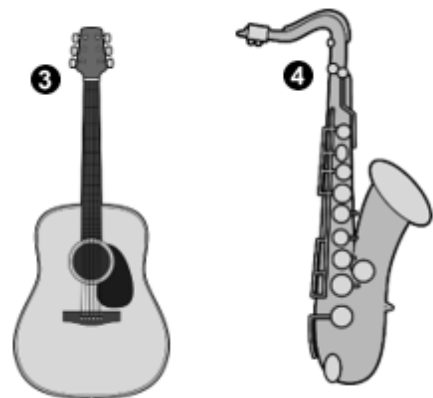
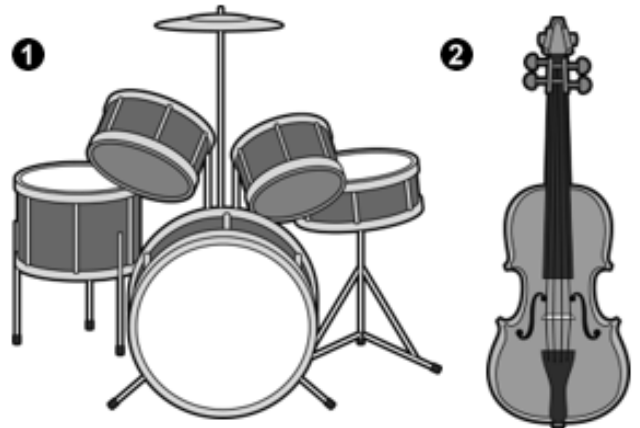

The Curse of Tutankhamun

When Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon discovered Tutankhamun's tomb, they were very happy. But at that moment, a mosquito flew into the tomb and bit Lord Carnarvon on the face. Seven weeks later, he died of pneumonia in a hotel room in Cairo.

Many months later, when Howard Carter examined Tutankhamun's body, he found a mosquito bite on the face, in the same place. Two men helped Carter examine Tutankhamun's body. They both died a short time after.

This wasn't the only strange thing that happened. The day they opened the tomb, Howard Carter's pet bird died. A cobra ate it. The cobra is the snake that protects Pharaohs after they die.

Lord Carnarvon had a dog called Susie. When he died in Cairo, his dog at home in England died at the same time. On the same night, at the same time, all the electricity in Cairo stopped and Cairo was dark. Was this all because of Tutankhamun?
